

A successful collaboration

Over the last 36 years, NOR-REG Systems have delivered nine packaging machines to Coop Kaffe in Oslo. Coop Kaffe, have recently placed an order for a further 2 wraparound machines. The first of these 2 new machines to pack their 250 gr and 500 gr standing bags has now been installed.

The daily machine output is equivalent to that of 3 manual packers over a two weeks period. Where in the past Coop Kaffe needed premium finished goods storage while they were completing a customer order, the installation of the wraparound machine allows them to produce the same order in just a fraction of that time, freeing up that premium storage for other customers' orders. This significant increase in production output makes Coop Kaffe more responsive and flexible to customer demand.

Coop Kaffe's factory Manager, Mr Ole Petter Corneliusen, has been extremely satisfied with the performance of the new machine and has received the full support of the Production Manager, Mr Knut Anderson and the Technical Manager, Mr Stein Skiaker.

The team at Coop Kaffe look forward to the delivery of the second machine later this year.



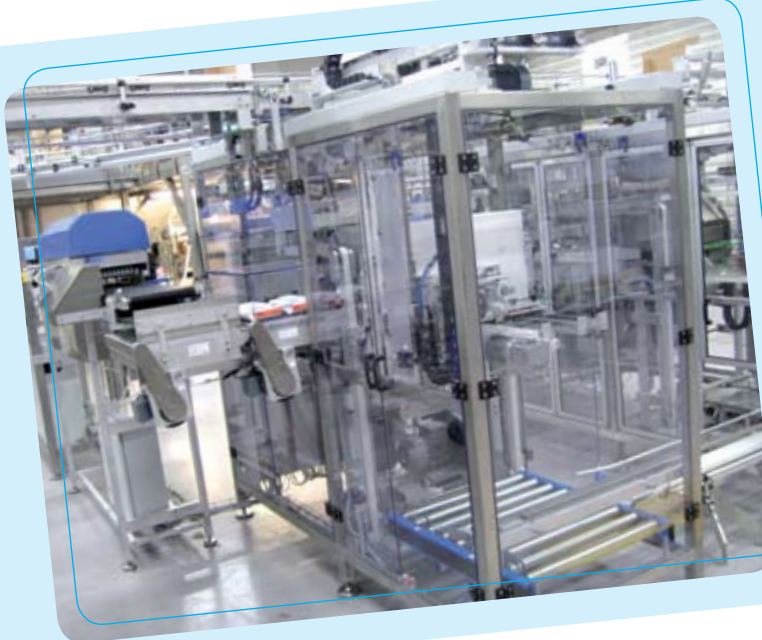

Sørlandschips with the world's fastest snack packer

Sørlandschips AS have recently installed the world's fastest snacks packer, a Nor-Reg TCP-200/600, with a capacity of up to 200 bags per minute. A first in Scandinavia! The bags are fed from a twin-bag-maker and they are merged, through a synchronised merging system, into the TCP-200/600 automatic case packer.

NOR-REG Systems delivered the first packing line to Sørlandschips back in 1998 and have since supplied all their end of line packaging equipment. Amazingly, Sørlandschips started in someone's garage with second-hand equipment. The entire production is now automated, with the exception of the potato washing and sorting area which has remained a manual operation. They produce 14 million bags per year, and the annual turnover is close to NOK 110 million.

Sørlandschips were acquired in 2008 by Scandza. Scandza want to make their mark in the snackfood industry and NOR-REG is pleased to have been selected as their partner of choice when it comes to automatic case packing.
